**ORDER GRANTING EX PARTE
EMERGENCY RELIEF**

The above-entitled matter came before the Honorable Francis J. Magill, Judge of Hennepin County District Court, on June 13, 2023, on Plaintiff's Motion for Emergency Ex Parte Relief.

Plaintiff alleges that his minor child, Michael Daniel Hart, d.o.b. March 5, 1985 is currently on life support at Hennepin County Medical Center, and will be removed from life support at 3:30 p.m. on June 13, 2023. He is asking the Court to prevent Hennepin County Medical Center from removing life support.

Plaintiff has sufficiently alleged that immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result to the applicant before the adverse party or that party's attorney can be heard in opposition. The Court finds that ex parte emergency relief is warranted in this case.

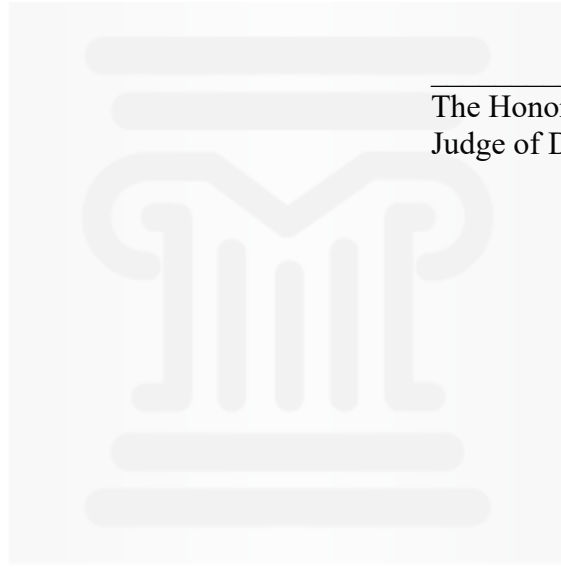
Based on all the files, records and proceedings herein, the Court makes the following:

ORDER

1. Plaintiff's Motion for Emergency Ex Parte Relief is **GRANTED**.
2. Defendant Hennepin County Medical Center shall not remove the minor child from life support until this matter can be fully heard.
