This class helped to demonstrate how a series of cases could be used to synthesize a rule, such as incorporating the different battery cases to form a unified definition of battery. The class also included a lot of difficult multiple choice questions which helped to think about and explore different multiple choice strategies as they will be needed for the bar.

- Knowledge of intentional torts and negligence.
