




Injuries induced by physician, medical treatment, or diagnostic procedures










# Goals Deter unsafe practices Compensate the injured









100,000 patients
4000 adverse events
1000 from malpractice
125 claims (only)
60 compensation
(+ to some of 3000
non-negligent)

60 compensated claims
20 before lawsuit
35 after lawsuit filed
5 at trial (verdict)

Only claims going to trial
weaker & MD usually win
